#### Council Continues With "Planning for the Future" - Update

At the Church Council meeting on April 10, the council again took up the congregation's ongoing agenda of "Planning for the Future". The recommendations from the Planning for the Future Committee and the suggestions received at the March 3rd Congregational Forum were reviewed.

The Council formed a subgroup of Hollie Kemper, Lauren Gallagher, Brenda Berger and Pastor Peter to produce a congregational "Time, Talent and Interest Survey" for distribution to the congregation in early summer. This is so that, as we prepare the present and future ministry at Muddy Creek, we may utilize the greatest assets that Muddy Creek has - its people! The subgroup met already on April 21 to begin preparing the survey. In conjunction with this, a Volunteer Fair is also planned for Sunday, September 8th ("God's Work, Our Hands Sunday") where Muddy Creek participants can sign up in person to volunteer for various tasks and committee work.

The Council researched the cost of an electronic road sign and discovered that it would cost \$50,000 - \$70,000 and would involve yearly permits and having to comply with state regulations, which include limiting us to one road sign total. Input was also given from the Evangelism Committee, which discussed the idea as well. The Committee proposed increased advertising of our church through means other than an electronic sign. The council decided that we would not pursue an electronic road sign, but that the Evangelism Committee would work on increasing our advertising and publicity to the community.

The Council was also reached out to by the Council President of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church in Ephrata, who are currently exploring various options, one of which includes the possibility of sharing a pastor with another congregation. They had contacted several local Lutheran churches, including ours. Muddy Creek Council's Executive Committee will set up a casual meeting with Holy Trinity's Executive Committee to discuss and learn more about what Holy Trinity is contemplating as we likewise plan for the future of Muddy Creek.

In other news, the Synod Assembly of our Lower Susquehanna Synod of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America will be held online on May 31 and in person on June 1 at St. Matthew Lutheran Church in York. Will Wood and Pastor Peter will be our delegates representing Muddy Creek. Will Wood also represented Muddy Creek at the Northern Lancaster Conference Meeting on April 18th.
